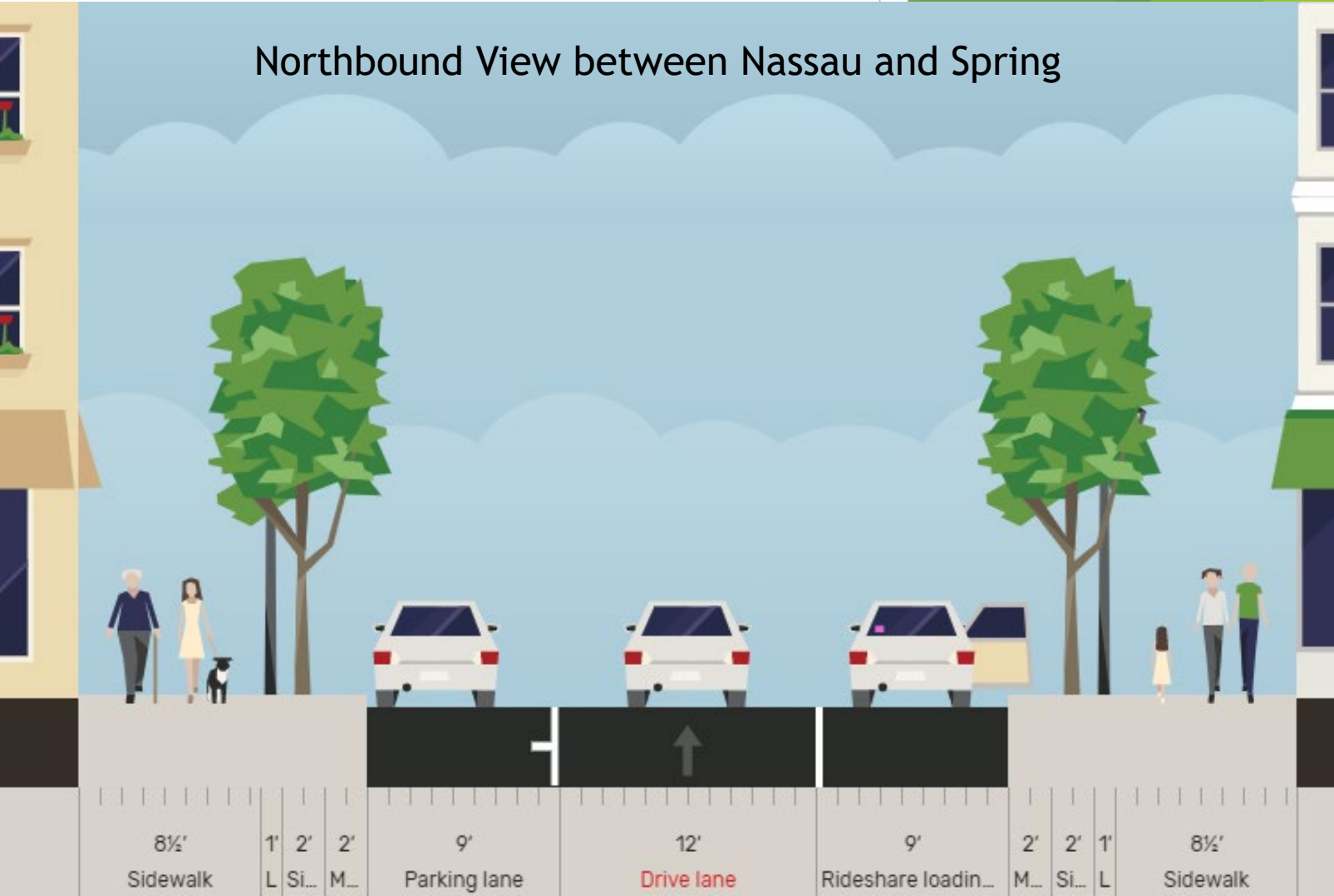
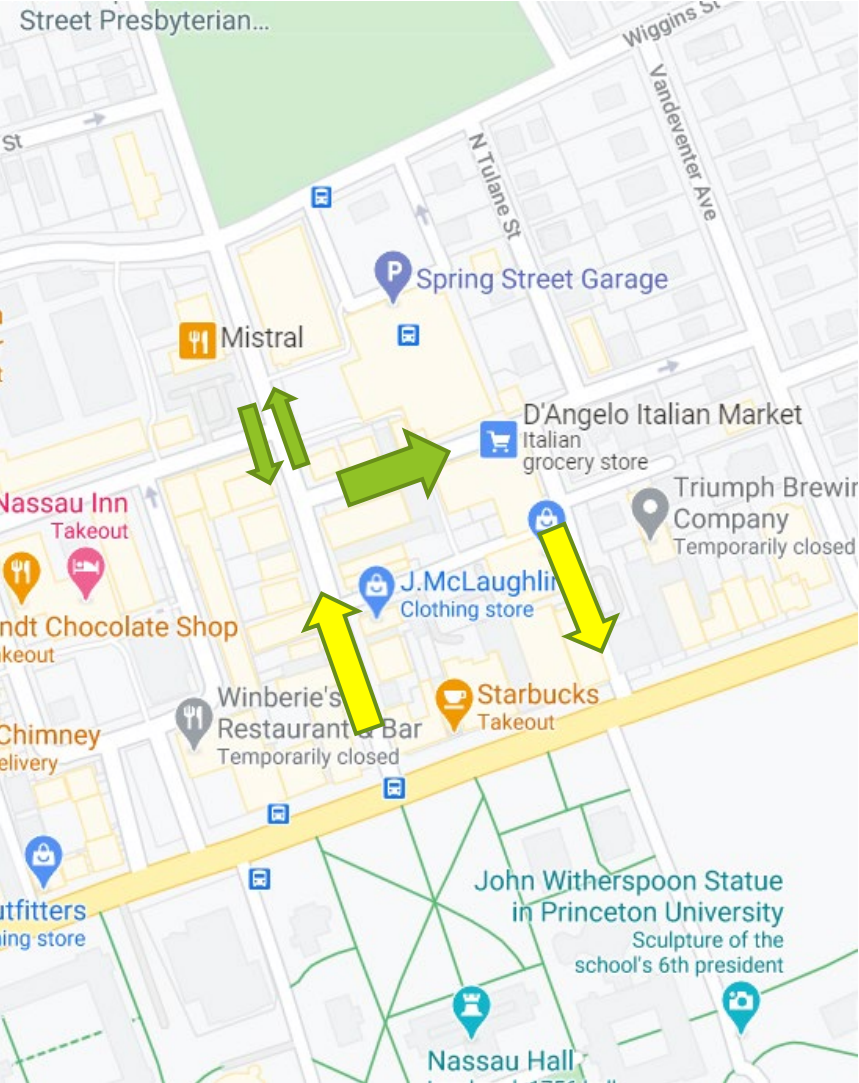


A - One-Way NB 27 to Spring With One Parking / Loading Lane (Covid Pilot)



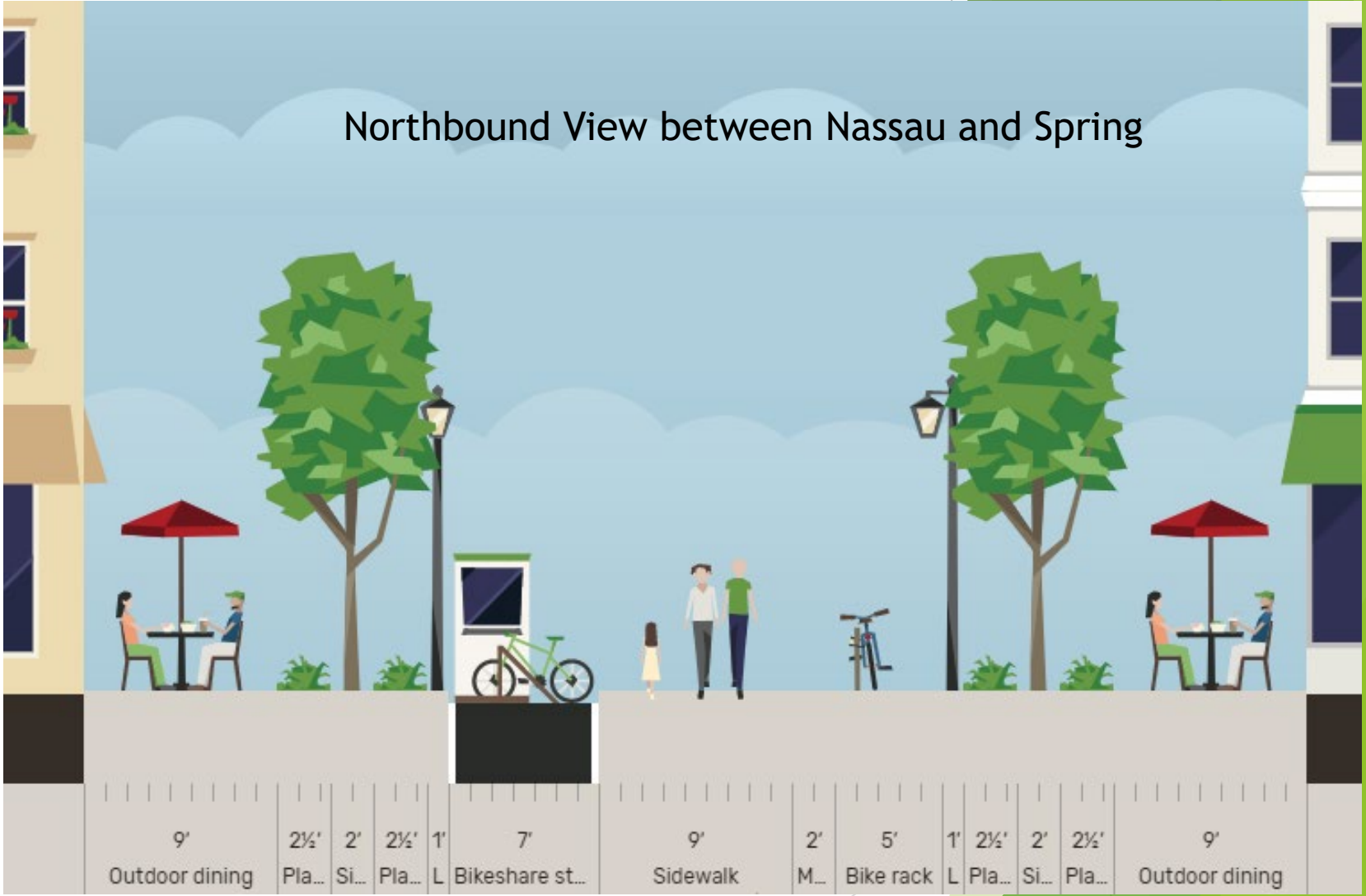
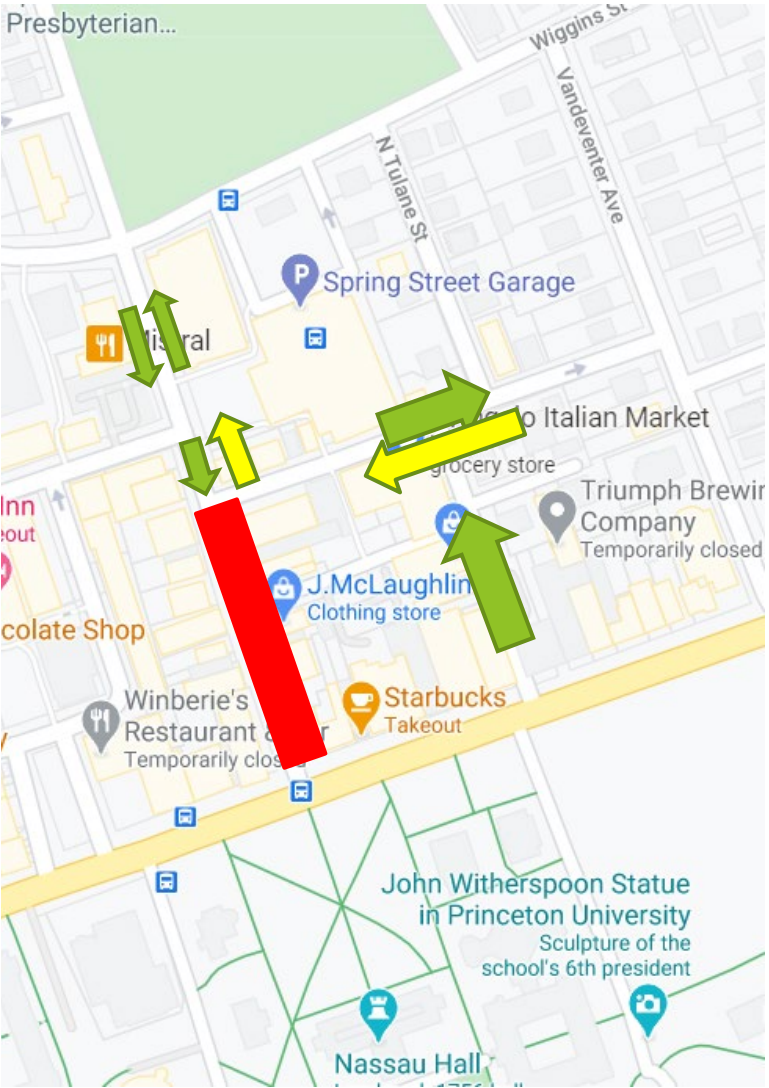
Yellow arrow indicates a potential traffic movement change for consideration by traffic professionals. Reversal of South Tulane is not required for the Witherspoon traffic change.

B - One-Way NB 27 to Spring With Two Parking / Loading Lanes



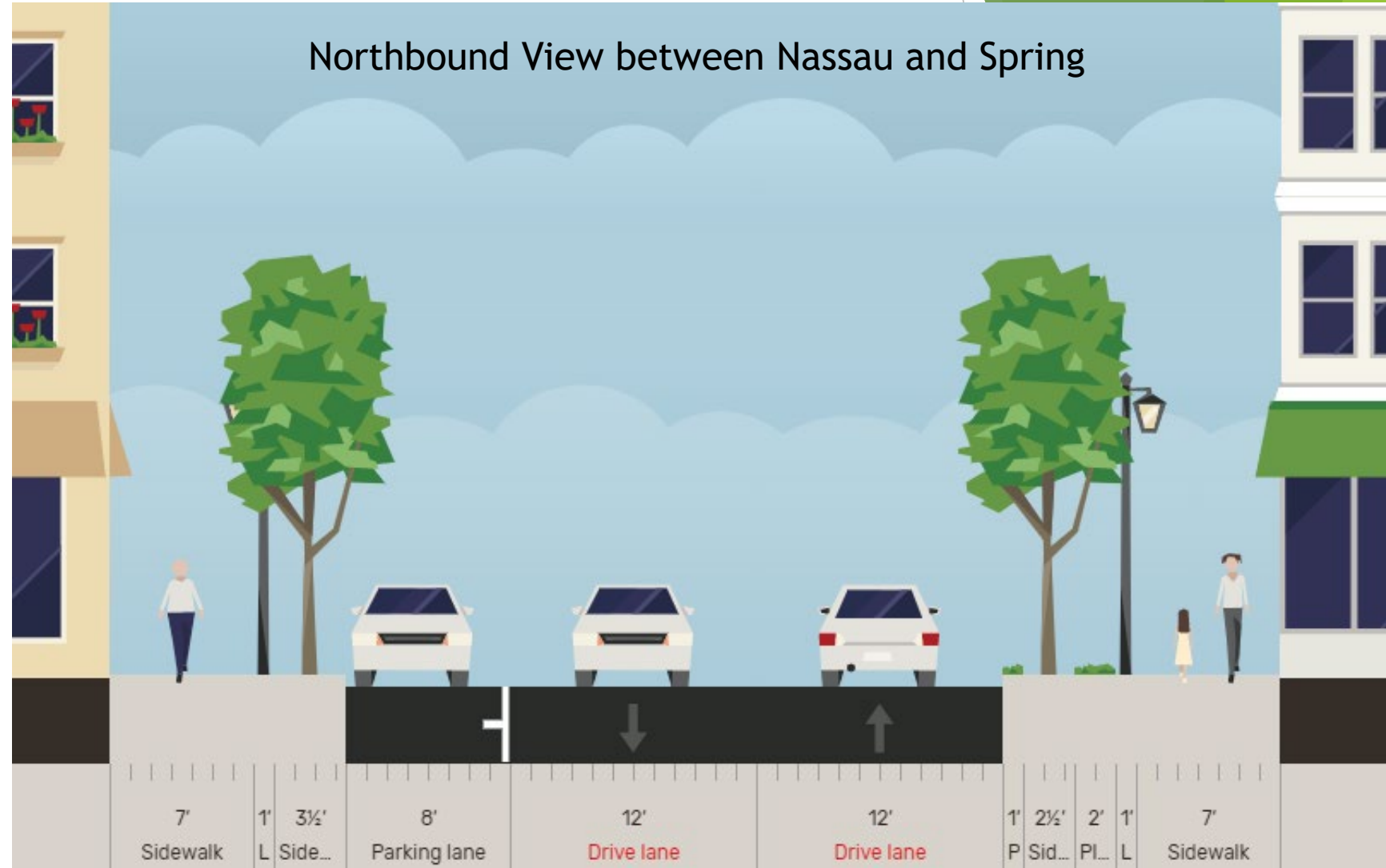
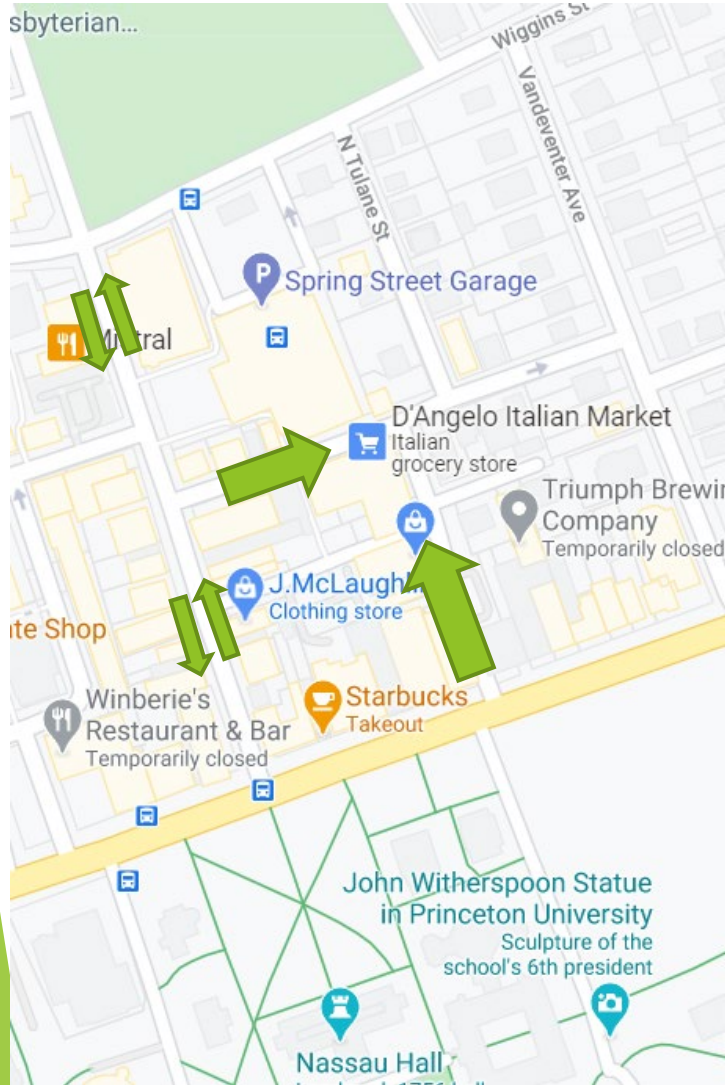
Yellow arrow indicates a potential traffic movement change for consideration by traffic professionals. Reversal of South Tulane is not required for the Witherspoon traffic change.

C - Closed to Motor Vehicles

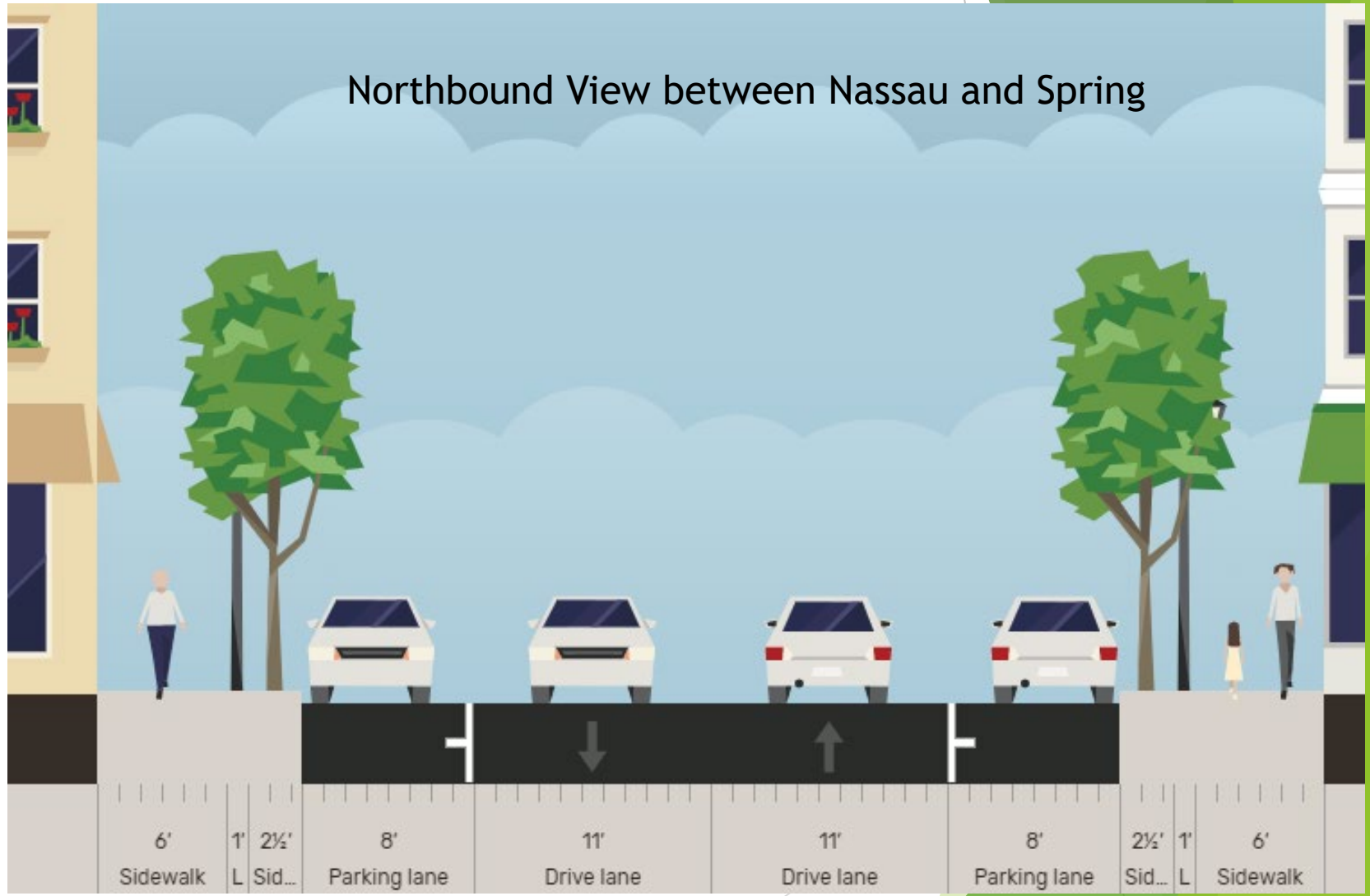
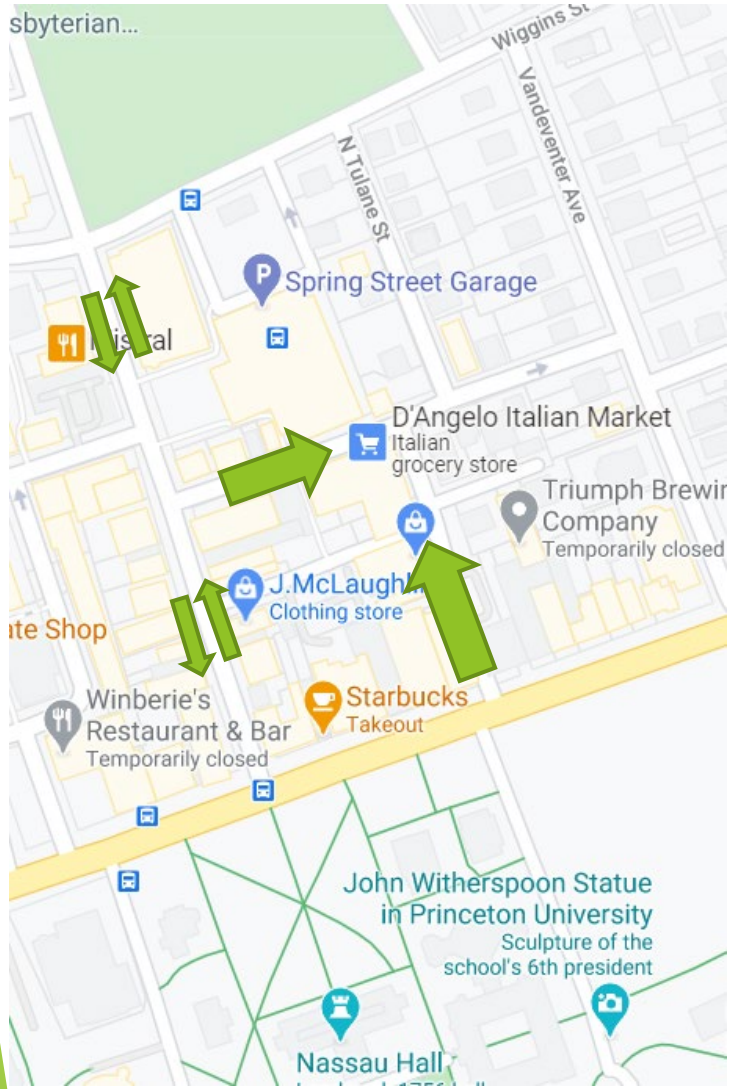
