IMPROVEMENTS TO LINDEN LANE AND SPRUCE STREET

Project Update Notice No. 18

December 14, 2020

Dear Linden Lane and Spruce Street Neighborhood Property Owners and Residents:

Princeton's emergency paving contractor will begin mobilizing some equipment to Spruce Street behind St. Paul's Church today, Monday, December 14. **Pavement repairs are scheduled to take place on Spruce Street, Maple Street, and Linden Lane on Tuesday, December 15.** The majority of the pavement repair work will occur on Spruce Street between Moore Street and Chestnut Street; however, pavement repairs will also occur at all of the sidewalk curb ramps and where pavement was removed along the edge of Spruce Street and Maple Street.

On Tuesday, Spruce Street residents between Moore Street and Maple Street are requested to remove their vehicles from their driveways prior to 7:00 am, if you plan to use your vehicle during the work day. The contractor will knock on the front doors within the work zone prior to work beginning to give residents one last opportunity to relocate their vehicles to legal parking spots on adjacent streets.

For everyone's safety, please use caution when driving in the work zones and be aware of construction equipment operating on the roadways. Do not walk across or allow pets to walk on the fresh pavement during the workday, as it retains heat and may damage your shoes or injure your pet's feet. Please allow extra time for potential delays caused by construction activities.

While construction is underway, Spruce Street between Moore Street and Maple Street, will be closed to all traffic Tuesday, 7:00 am – 5:00 pm. On-street parking in the work area shall be prohibited while work is taking place. Residents shall park on surrounding streets during construction work hours. The road section will be open at the end of each work day. If you need to park overnight on a municipal street, a temporary parking placard can be issued. Please contact Tiffany Smith, tsmith@princetonnj.gov, to obtain a placard. Vehicle information will be given to parking enforcement and police to prevent tickets being issued.

Despite our best efforts to notify service providers, we advise that there will most likely be disruptions to garbage collection and recycling when work is taking place. Please report a missed trash pickup via SeeClickFix or report a missed recycling pickup to Mercer County Improvement Authority (contact information for both on page 3). In cases of an emergency, the contractor will accommodate all emergency vehicles into a work zone. Access for services and deliveries within the work area may be limited during construction. If special accommodations are required, please advise us at your earliest convenience.

Please refrain from placing any leaf debris at the curb for collection after Monday, December 14.

Ian Baker, Construction Engineer, is the main point of contact. Ian Baker and Tiffany Smith, Inspector, will be on-site daily while a contractor is on-site to observe the work. A project contact list is provided on the next page of this notice.
