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IMPROVEMENTS TO LINDEN LANE AND SPRUCE STREET Project Update Notice No. 30 December 14, 2021

Dear Linden Lane and Spruce Street Neighborhood Property Owners and Residents:

The below sequence of construction activities is weather dependent conditional upon dry weather and temperatures that are 40°F and rising. In the event of inclement weather (wet and cold conditions), the contractor will postpone work until the next day with ideal weather conditions

On Thursday, December 16th, Straight Edge, a subcontractor of Black Rock Enterprises, LLC, will be installing pavement markings on the entire length of Spruce Street and Linden Lane (Nassau Street to Hamilton Avenue) between the hours of 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. The road will be closed to through traffic; resident traffic may be allowed. The contractor is expected to begin on Spruce Street at Moore Street and work their way east towards Spruce Circle on a block-by-block basis; afterwards they will move to Linden Lane. Once each section is marked, the road section would be opened and available for use.

“NO PARKING” signs will be posted on Spruce Street and Linden Lane prior to this work. DO NOT PARK on Spruce Street or Linden Lane as your vehicle may be subject to tow. Residents should park their vehicles on adjacent side streets (Hamilton, Pine, Chestnut, Moore, etc.) if they need to use them during construction hours. Residents may leave their vehicles parked in their driveways if they do not plan to utilize them during construction hours.

On Thursday, December 16th, GPRS, a subcontractor of Black Rock Enterprises, LLC, will be conducting video inspection of the Sanitary Sewer main and laterals on Linden Lane from 39 / 40 Linden Lane to Hamilton Avenue intersection between the hours of 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. The road will be closed to passing through traffic; resident and local traffic may be allowed. We request that you limit heavy water use, such as laundry, dishwashers and long showers during this time; flushing toilets periodically is ok.

For everyone’s safety, please use caution when driving in the work zones and be aware of construction equipment operating on the roadways. Sidewalk detours will be installed while work is taking place if pedestrian traffic is to be disrupted. Please allow extra time for potential delays caused by construction activities.

Garbage and recycling service providers have been notified of construction. Despite our best efforts, we advise that there will most likely be disruptions to garbage collection and recycling when work is taking place. Please report a missed trash pickup via SeeClickFix, or report a missed recycling pickup to Mercer County Improvement Authority (contact information for both on page 3). In cases of an emergency, the contractor can accommodate all emergency vehicles into a work zone. Access for services and deliveries within the construction limits shall be maintained at all times during construction. If special accommodations are required, please advise us at the earliest convenience.

Ian Baker, Construction Engineer, is the main point of contact. Tiffany Smith, Engineering Inspector, will be on-site daily while the contractor is working to observe the work. A project contact list is provided on the next page of this notice.

We will send out regular notifications, by email regarding the project progress, changes to access, etc. as the work resumes. These notices will also be posted on the project website at <https://www.princetonnj.gov/238/Linden-Lane-Spruce-Moran-Avenue-Maple>.
